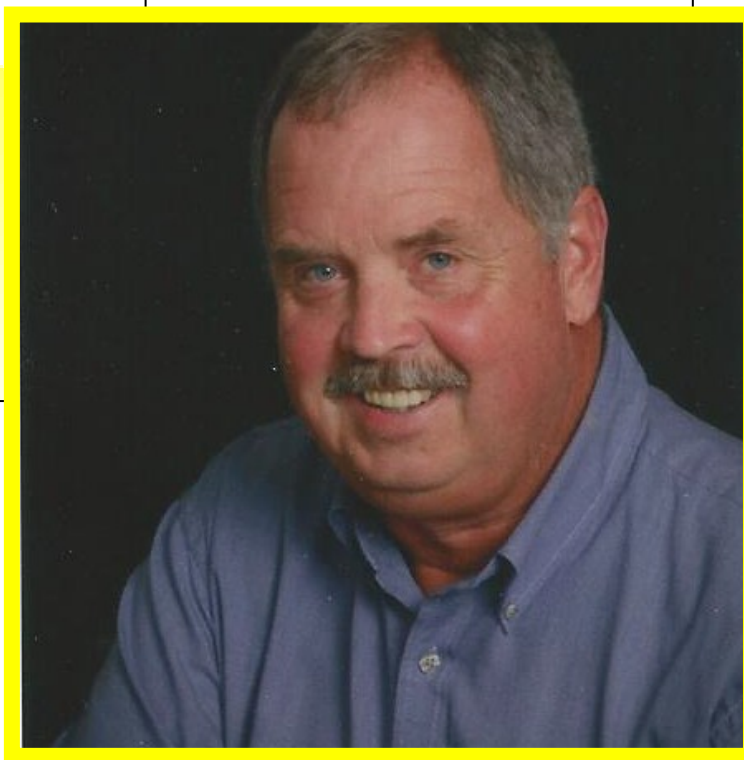




VOLUNTEER SPOTLIGHT

My job of collecting cans is a smelly, dirty job, but knowing that the funds received from the donated cans will be used to pay for the construction of a Habitat house is very rewarding. Larry has picked up cans from golf courses, Binder Lake Ball Fields, and most all of the 20 can cottages around Jefferson City. Since 2013, it is likely that Larry has handled over 56,000 pounds of cans. And since there are between 35 and 40 cans per pound, that translates to over 2 million cans with a value of nearly \$30,000 for Habitat.
